Handcraft



The Handcraft competition is open to all Beavers and Cubs in the District. Programmes are issued several months in advance and they young people have the chance to enter an item in several different categories. This years Cub Handcraft includes: painted glass, decorated pringles tin, Jungle Book collage, knotting display, keyring and an any other exhibit category. In addition there is a Pack Effort which is worked on by all members of the Pack, this year it is a mobile. The Beavers operate on a similar principle.

The 9th tend to devote a month of work on a Tuesday night to Handcraft entries allowing all the young people an opportunity to enter at least some of the classes. Otherwise work from home is accepted subject to the rules printed on the programme.

Be sure to get your entries in on the Friday as the district team need all of Friday night to arrange them so that the judges can come in on Saturday morning and do their job.
